Exclusion of the Associates:

Article Thirteenth: the Associates shall be excluded only and if they perform public denigration or offense to the Association of Sistema CETYS Universidad or one of the works, or if they violate or fail to fulfill the Articles of Incorporation hereof, or commit actions or behavior contrary to moral and good practices as judged by the Associates Assembly, who may agree exclusion trough the vote of two thirds of the attendants to the Assembly in which the corresponding agreement is made.

Article Fourteenth: The proposals regarding the exclusion or separation of Associates shall be presented to be considered, evaluated, investigated and decided by a Committee that shall be specifically designed to said effect by the Executive Commission. The Committee assigned thereof will disperse once the decision is made before the Assembly. Any Associate that has been excluded from the Association shall not be accepted again as member of the Association nor shall participate in any of the institutions of the Association.

Article Fifteenth: In the event that an Associate is dismissed by exclusion, death or any reason, he will loose in favor of the Association the rights granted in the Articles of Incorporation stated herein and in terms of the Article two thousand five hundred fifty five of the Civil Code for the State of Baja California.

Article Sixteenth: The Association shall keep a book of records of the Associates, containing the information related to the date of admission, and distinctive participation of each Associate as in the terms of this Incorporation Articles.

The Patrimony of the Association:

Article Seventeenth: The Patrimony of the Association shall constitute with allotments, donations and income of any kind as received by the Association. The Association will assign every asset to the objects exclusively specified as the social object herein and will not be allowed to grant benefits on the remaining, to be distributed to any physical person or among the constituent physical or moral person, unless it refers to one of the moral person authorized in Article 97 of the Income Tax Law thereof, or in the event of a remuneration for services received. This Article may not be revoked.

Associates Assembly:

Article Eighteenth: The supreme organ of the Association shall be the Associates Assembly. The Assemblies called can be ordinary or extraordinary. Ordinary assemblies shall be in charge of solving matters that do not require agreement from an Extraordinary Assembly.
