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Introduction.

This report integrates data and findings from the institutional assessment effort carried out from 2008 to 2013.

Institutional Assessment Performance Distribution.

Findings:

The results reflect that the Institution's areas of improvement are in the ILOs one and three. The Institutional Learning Outcome 1 (Clear and effective communication in Spanish) seems to be where students have most challenges, specifically in the organization of ideas and content, which is directly related to Critical thinking (ILO3).

Students' seem to be improving significantly in the second Institutional Learning outcome: Lifelong learning.
