

Master's Degree in International and Corporate Law 2012 – 2015 Assessment Plan

Before the rapid changes in the business world at the international level, the Mission of the program of the **Master's Degree in Corporate and International Law** is to meet the demand for professionals in the public sector and that the national, international, and multinational exporting companies in the region and in the country require, and that they engage in commercial transactions between two or more countries.

In order to comply with an institutional commitment regarding student assessment during 2010, some of the institutional learning outcomes were measured; however, the ones from the different graduate programs are still pending. For that reason, the Coordination of the Master's degree in International and Corporate Law proposes that in the next three years, from January 2012, we start an assessment exercise to measure the learning outcomes contained in the 13 syllabi, and that are distributed in 4 modules:
